- b. **STEP TWO**: The Guidance Counselor will acknowledge receipt of your Student Application form and discuss dates for testing. The dates for testing are to be scheduled by the Guidance Counselor. A placement test will be given to all prospective students for grades second through twelfth.
- c. **STEP THREE**: Upon notification of acceptance, the parent must make all required payments within specified time.
